Judging Criteria (1) Composition, (2) Edges-Interest, (3) Draftsmanship/Perspective/Drawing, (4) Color-Value

Subject Matter Water! Any type of water, or water-related object or location—still, moving, contained, or marine. Water does not need to be the primary focal point, but it should reflect the theme. Entries must be painted in the “en plein air style.” No nudes or studio-set still life. All works need to have been painted in 2009-2010.

Canvas Size 5x7 through 14x18 (or square inch equivalent)

Entry & Image Submission

- **Enter Online:** October 12 – October 15, 2010; two images maximum submission
- **Fees:** Professional \$35.00, Non-professional \$15.00

- Images should be sized 1920 x 1920 p 72 dpi. Instructions for sizing and an auto-sizing tool are available on the OJS (Online Juried Shows) website.

Notifications E-mails will be sent to all submitting artists for each image on October 22, 2010. They will be designated as Accepted, Alternate, or Not Accepted.

Painting Delivery *Drop off:* Monday, Nov. 1, and Tuesday, Nov. 2, 2010, 1:00 - 5:00 p.m.
Pick Up: Monday, Jan 3, and Tuesday, Jan. 4., 2011, 1:00 - 5:00 p.m.

Paintings must be framed by association standards with flat-lying wired grommets 1/3 from the top. Grommets on a thick frame are to be only 3” from the top or it will topple forward on the hanging system. Hanging system hooks go into the grommets, not under the wire. Artist’s Name, Phone #, Title & Price must be on the back and Alternates must be wrapped for protection.

Bin Paintings Accepted artists may submit up to 2 unframed Bin paintings for the duration of the show. Sizes: no minimum – 14 x 18 maximum (including mat). *\$150 minimum price. Clear bin envelopes available at gallery. Artist Name, Phone, Title & Price must on the back. Please cover any busy, ugly, & messy backs of canvas with plain paper.

Staffing the Gallery Accepted and Alternate artists are required to staff the gallery for at least two shifts during the run of the show. Be prepared to select your dates on drop-off day. Gallery Staff Manager: Josh Nolan (949) 494-2903

Sales The NHNM handles all sales at the cashier’s desk inside the museum (cash, check & credit cards), collects all sales tax, and issues checks to Artists. Artists do not need individual Sales Licenses. Commissions: Artists 50%, NHNM 40%, and SOCALPAPA 10% for gallery promotion. The only discount on sales is the 10% NHNM Member of \$100 Level or above, verified by NHNM sales desk.

Disclosure Paintings are to be for sale and remain in the gallery for the duration of the show, if not sold. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. SOCALPAPA, NHNM or any of its members will assume no liability for loss, theft, or damage during all phases of this event. Artists participating in the Juried Events of this show agree to allow SOCALPAPA and NHNM reproduction privileges of their award winning art for education, fund raising, or publicity purposes only.
