Criteria: Composition, Edges-Interest, Draftsmanship-Perspective-Drawing, Color-Value

Eligibility: Participants must be current members of SOCALPAPA, and the Newport Harbor Nautical Museum

Entry & Image Submission:

Enter online: Aug. 23rd - Aug. 26th (2) sets of 2 Images maximum submission

Fees: Professional \$35, Non-professional \$15

Canvas Size: ***Small study sizes:*** from 9x12 to 12x16 (or square inch equivalent)

Large studio sizes: from 20x24 to 30x40 (or square inch equivalent)

Subject Matter: Any landscape, seascape, cityscape subject matter. Figures only if not primary subject matter. No nudes.

All submissions should have been painted in 2009 or 2010, although artists are encouraged to paint something specifically for this show. Our hope for the show is to give our artists an opportunity to expand past an field easel size painting and give our patron an insight to development of larger work.

Submission: Enter Online from **August 23rd - 26th** Submit images to <http://www.onlinejuriedshows.com>

Images should be sized 1920 x 1920ppi. Instructions for sizing and an auto-sizing tool are available on the web-site.

Notifications: Emails will be sent to all submitting artists, one for each set of images, on Saturday Sept. 4th, designating each set as Accepted, Alternate, or Not Accepted.

Painting Drop Off: Monday & Tuesday, Sept. 13 & 14, 1 - 5 pm

Paintings must be ready to hang - Wired with large, flat lying gromets, Name, Title & Price on the back. Alternates must be wrapped for protection.

Reception: Saturday, Sept. 18th, 4 - 6 pm

Painting Pick-up: Monday & Tuesday, November 1st & 2nd 1-5 pm. If you send someone to pick up your painting, they must bring a copy of your yellow Artist Participation Form in order to pick up your painting.

Sales: The NHNM handles all sales at the cashier's desk inside museum (cash, check & credit cards), collects all sales tax, and issues checks to Artists. Artists do not need individual Sales Licences. Commissions: Artists 50%, NHNM 40% and SOCALPAPA 10% for gallery promotion. The only discount on sales is the 10% NHNM Member of \$100 Level or above, verified by NHNM sales desk

Staffing the Gallery Accepted and Alternate artists are required to staff the gallery for at least 2 shifts during the run of the show. Be prepared to select your dates on Drop-off day.

Disclosure Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Southern California Plein Air Painters Association, NHNM or any of its members will assume no liability for the loss, theft, or damage during all phases of this event. Artists participating in the Juried Events of this show agree to allow SOCALPAPA and NHNM reproduction privileges of their award winning art for education, fund raising, or publicity purposes only. By submitting this entry the participant acknowledges their responsibilities.
